Keep McAllen Beautiful (KMB) is in search of a Mural Artist to paint a 408 foot wall located on Pecan & 2nd Street. KMB will pay for project materials & provide a stipend to the artist. Funding is being provided by the City of McAllen and Don't mess with Texas® Campaign.

Theme: Don't mess with Texas®

Original artwork submitted must incorporate the spirit of "Don't mess with Texas®" and the goal of keeping Texas litter-free. The Campaign is a signature initiative for TxDOT's litter prevention program to help educate the public regarding the battle against litter. The most common forms of litter are food or organic material such as banana peels and apple cores, cigarette butts, small pieces of paper, such as receipts, gum wrappers and lottery tickets.

Design should incorporate a Don't mess with Texas® logo or wording (examples below). TxDOT will license the official Don't mess with Texas® logo and trademark to the city at no cost. An agreement with your city legal department will be executed.

PARTICIPATION RULES: Design concept should be submitted to Keep McAllen Beautiful with artist's portfolio or previous works in JPEG, PNG, or PDF format, along with any explanatory notes the artist may want to include. Artwork must be designed to fit the wall. We will contact all entrants after selection process to let them know if their concept was selected for the project.
